**Homeless Services**

1. What can DHS do to assist us with converting the Sumner Avenue Shelter into a multi-use facility with cultural, educational and recreational space?

**Sanitation**

1. Can the sanitation garage for Community Board 3 begin construction without additional delay?
2. Can funds be set aside for DSNY to employ additional Sanitation Enforcement Officers so that some of the nuisance items be enforced more rigorously?

**Department for the Aging**

1. Can programs be funded to education our senior population in the area of predatory practices so they will be forewarned?
2. Can congregate meals programs be continued or enhanced in the senior centers throughout the area to promote nutrition to our senior population?
